NARRATOR: Michal Morris has worked in the community sector in Victoria for over 25 years, and recently left her role as CEO of inTouch Multicultural Centre Against Family Violence in Victoria, where she made a significant contribution to the organisation through the challenges of covid and family violence reforms in Victoria, overseeing the rapid expansion of services, developing and implementing a national policy agenda, and the establishment of a range of innovative services including a post recovery program, inSpire, along with survivor Advocate group NOOR.

In 2022 Michal was inducted into the Victorian Women's Honour role, acknowledging her long career, and recognising her strong leadership of inTouch throughout the covid 19 pandemic. Prior to this role, Michal has worked across sectors and government to advocate for and deliver improved health and wellbeing outcomes with a focus on migrant and refugee communities.

The tangible outcomes from Michal's time at inTouch reflect her long-term impact and her steady and creative leadership in the sector has directly improved the lives of many people.
